# Magnolia Stitchers

We had a really terrific meeting in March, including a new member – Debbie Moore from Indian Land, SC. We will be working on an appliqué block for April and the following couple of months – depends on how fast we ALL get it done. A diagram was handed out and fabrics were discussed – the actual pattern will be handed out at the April meeting – it will be a bit larger than the diagram so you won't be able to start ahead of time!!

Please remember to bring your appliqué sewing kit along with the fabrics you will be using – pieces about twice the size of the bird parts diagram should be big enough. Also bring your appliqué thread if you have it – Sandy will bring her supply to help you along. A 12-1/2” to 13” light square of background will be just fine. Freezer paper – Reynold's brand only is also needed. We will be using the needle-turn method but you can use any other method you want – except fusible. If you need appliqué glue or tarch or any other tools bring them, too. It's much better to have too much than not enough in your sewing box.

Call me for any information. I will be out of town from the 14<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup> and a bit slow on the 22<sup>nd</sup> (having my left cataract fixed) – but please feel free to call using my cell phone – any time! You can also text my cell or email me at the address below.



☒ = cut in half twice diagonally


**4 Assorted Prints**  
from each

- 1 square (A) 2" x 2"
- 1 square 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" ☐ (B)
- 1 square 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" ☒ (C)
- 1 square (D) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" ☐ (D)

**Cream Tone-on-Tone**

- 1 square 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" ☒ (C)
- 4 squares (E) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

If you make just one block, you will have extra B, C and D patches. Noticing the placement of the various prints, join the patches as shown in the diagram to make the block. ☐
