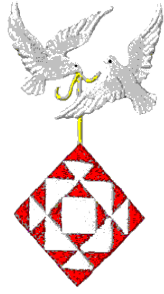

Minutes for June 6, 2018

Minutes of Meeting

June 6, 2018

Sandy Bruce opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. Jean Miller led the group in a prayer. The minutes of the last meeting were approved by all.

Wedding Ring Donation Quilt: Linda Yaggie embroidered a beautiful label for Chris Carlin to attach when she sews on the binding. Chris B. had an estimate of \$50.00 for 1,000 tickets, printed and cut. However, the tickets will not be perforated but we can work with that. Chris C. will provide size of quilt so Chris B. can order tickets. Sandy will take a picture of the quilt. Karen Keys agreed to handle distribution/sale of tickets and will search out venues. Sandy suggested the Christmas bazaar held at the Senior

Center, perhaps with some other small items to sell.

Quilts on Wheels: Vicki brought in the last of Peggy Cooper's fabrics which had been stored at her place. Some of the pieces are even 3 to 5 yards so they will be good for backing. Jan Futrell recommended testing the old fabric before using since she has had quilts come sandwiched for quilting and the old fabric just shredded.

July Calendar & Picnic: Because the July 4th holiday falls on the first Wednesday of the month, we will move our picnic to Wednesday, July 11th. Chris Blankenship has offered to host the picnic at her home starting at our regular time of about 9:30 a.m. Bring a light, picnic type dish or dessert and your own drink.
