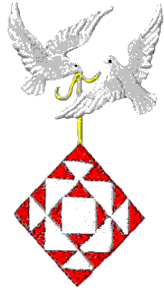

## Minutes for September, 2018

### Minutes of Meeting

**September 5, 2018**

Co-leader Sandy Bruce opened the meeting at 10:00 a.m.

Sherry Reinhardt, Director, and Sue Gauthier, Service Coordinator, of Coalition Against Child Abuse & Child Advocacy attended our meeting and were given 20 of our donation quilts for distribution to abused children. Sherry explained the purpose of their group is to teach teachers and others how to recognize abuse and how to report it. Child Advocacy works with social workers, police and district attorneys to deal with cases of abuse. Our quilts will be used to “cover the children with love” while they are being examined and questioned. Sherry and Sue really appreciate the gift of quilts on behalf of their clients.

**Christmas Luncheon:** Sandy reported that our Christmas luncheon will be on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of December rather than the 1<sup>st</sup>.
