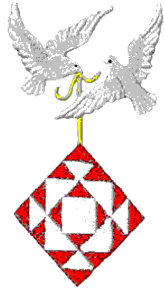

## Things you may want to know!

Barbara Barrier gave an interesting program: "An Eclectic Quilter". Her work shows us she is. She had the most unusual patterns and techniques on her gorgeous quilts. We enjoyed her program.

At our November 7 Guild Meeting Jean Funderburk will be giving an interactive program entitled "**Making Faces**". We will explore face composition by creating a self-portrait or making a face from your wildest imagination. You can make it realistic or off the wall intended to be light hearted and fun. Hands on

program using your choice of paper or fabric.

### **Supply List is:**

Paper: Construction paper, card stock, scrap book paper, some of all of them in a variety of colors.

For Face (flesh), eye parts, nose, mouth, cheeks, chin, hair and so on. Refer to the fabric supplies.

Paper Cutting Scissors

Glue Stick (washable or permanent).

Elmer's Glue

Optional: baby wipes to clean sticky fingers.

### **Fabric:**

Base/**background:** flesh tone fat quarter

**Eyes:** White, black, iris color your choice

**Eyebrows:** Color of your choice

**Nose:** darker and lighter flesh colors or whatever makes you happy

**Mouth:** two colors of your choice, top lip dark, bottom lip lighter

**Hair:** your choice

Fabric cutting scissors

Glue stick (washable or permanent) permanent fabric glue

Solids and/or small prints that read as solid, extra black fabric

Batik fabrics have a high thread count and do not ravel as easy

For marking placement, drawing or tracing shapes: pencil. Especially for fabric Fixion pens.
